

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE
INTERAGENCY COOPERATION CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE TEXAS FACILITIES COMMISSION
AND
HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION**

This Amendment No. 1 is entered into by and between the Texas Facilities Commission (hereinafter referred to as "Owner"), a state agency located at 1711 San Jacinto Boulevard, Austin, Texas 78701 and the Health and Human Services Commission (hereinafter referred to as "Receiving Agency"), located at 4900 North Lamar, Austin, Texas 78751, to amend the original contract for minor construction services between the parties effective August 30, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as "Contract").

WHEREAS, changed circumstances require mutually desirable alterations in the duration to the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend certain terms to their mutual benefit to reflect the changed circumstances;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The parties agree to modify ARTICLE IV – PAYMENT FOR SERVICES, by adding SECTION 4.05 – CAPITAL BUDGET AUTHORITY, as follows:

"4.05. CAPITAL BUDGET AUTHORITY. Pursuant to Rider 15 entitled *Capital Construction on Behalf of State Agencies* for TFC found in the GAA, Acts 2017, S.B. 1, 85th Leg., R.S., art. I (Facilities Commission), any capital items related to construction of buildings and facilities including minor construction projects greater than \$250,000 performed by TFC on behalf of other state agencies do not apply to TFC for the purpose of the capital budget rider limitations specified in the GAA, Acts 2017, S.B. 1, 85th Leg., R.S., art. IX, sec. 14.03. By signing this Contract, Receiving Agency certifies it has the requisite capital budget authority to fund the services to be provided under this Contract."

2. The parties agree to modify ARTICLE V – TERM OF CONTRACT, SECTION 5.01 – TERM, by deleting the entire paragraph and replacing it with the following:

"This Contract shall be effective as of the date of the last party to sign, and shall terminate on August 31, 2018, unless terminated earlier by either party, as provided in Section 5.03."

Except as expressly amended above, the Contract remains in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have made and executed this Amendment No. 1 to this Contract to be effective as of December 31, 2017.




