JOB SUMMARY:

Performs senior level Windows server and computer systems administration both locally and remotely. Work includes daily administration of the Active Directory and Azure environment on both VM's and physical machines as well as virtual system management on VMware environments. Design and management of new system enhancements. Develops policies and procedures and implements them to support State modernization plans and improve security. Provide escalation support for less knowledgeable techs. Works under general supervision with large latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment. Moderate networking duties to include configuring switch ports, VLANs, and troubleshooting connections and working with network staff for resolution. Coordinate with stakeholders to support their needs and requirements. Automate recurrent tasks with scripting and automation.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Maintains the VMware vSphere environment to include upgrading, installing necessary software and security updates and patches, testing changes to the systems and maintains overall health of the enterprise VM environment
- Onboards various storage systems and configures datastores to existing environments. Configures and designs backup plans and systems for data security and disaster recovery for production systems.
- Monitors and responds to alerts and issues by initiating warranty repairs, replacing hardware, and working with vendor support to resolves issues.
- Installs and manages the enterprise network management software. Responsibilities include setting up alerts for all nodes and ensures asset inventory and configuration mapping stays current and complete.
- Assists the Agency's network team with deployment of network hardware and assists with issues related to network environment.
- Submits change management requests for approval and develops test, implementation and backup out plans for new changes
- Develop and deploy servers and workstations that supports the Risk Management, Building Automation and Life Safety divisions.
- Develops and maintains images for desktops, servers, VM environments and VM templates, etc.
- Maintain and improve procedures for inventory control of IT assets.
- Performs related work as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in computer science, computer information systems, MIS, or a related field. Work experience may be substituted in lieu of education requirement.
- Six (6) years' experience in systems administration and network management, including three (3) years supervisory or lead worker experience.

- Experience with VMware host and VM configuration and deployment
- Experience in local, campus and wide area network systems.
- Valid State of Texas driver's license.
- Experience in server and workstation systems administration in a virtual and physical environment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS AND/OR WORKING CONDITIONS:

This classification functions in a standard office environment. There are no unusual dangers involved, but the position will have exposure to dust, environmental allergens, pathogens, and other microorganisms consistent with business activities and human contact. The position holder must be able to work effectively with people under varying conditions, must be able to work extended periods at a computer, and must be able to work longer than eight hours in a work-day as necessary. Physical requirements also include the ability to move items up to 40 lbs. and perform tasks requiring fine motor skills and coordination.

Conditions of Employment:

Initial screening is based on the Education and Experience minimum qualifications defined in the job posting. Interviewee selection is based on applicant information explaining how they meet each Competency (Knowledge, Skills and Abilities) requirement. If selected for interview, all veterans must provide a DD214 long form. Official transcripts or other minimum requirement validations will be requested at the time of interview.

As part of its employment process, TFC may procure or have prepared a criminal background check. An applicant with an unsatisfactory criminal background check report is ineligible to be hired for the position for which the report is initiated.

Driver's record check will be conducted by the agency. Satisfactory driving records are required for driving state or personal vehicles and motor driven equipment to conduct agency business. If hired, employee must provide document(s) within three (3) days of hire date that establish identity and employment eligibility. A complete list of acceptable documents is on file with the local Texas Workforce Commission office.
