Austin Pride Parade - Saturday, August 23

Increased traffic is expected along the downtown parade route and in the Capitol Complex parade staging area. The parade will proceed from the staging area down Congress Ave. to Congress St. Bridge where it de-stages. Streets will open as the parade passes.

- 1:00 PM 11:59 PM San Jacinto Blvd. between 15th and 11th St. will be closed as a staging area.
- Paid parking for parade participants is available in State garages.
- Ample State employee parking is available for those working Saturday. Parking may be accessed from Trinity St. Pedestrian routes to buildings will remain accessible.
 7:00 PM - 11:59 PM - 5th and 6th St. at Congress Ave. will be closed.
 5:00 PM - 12:00 AM - 4th St. from Lavaca St. to Congress Ave. will be closed.

Product Activation - Friday, August 22 & Sunday, August 24

Back-to-school event will be held at the corner of San Jacinto Blvd. and 15th St. at the old Megabus stop. This event will not impact State business; however increased traffic is expected. Organizers will use public parking on Friday, Aug. 22nd; then on Sunday, Aug. 24th, paid parking will be used in Garage B and at parking meters.

After-Hours State Employee Parking

State employees (with texas.gov emails) are permitted one FREE after-hours event parking permit on a first come, first served basis. State employees must register for FREE after-hours event and Garage N daytime parking by using the parking contractor webpage link:

State employees must use the above link to register for parking in advance or scan the onsite QR Code for each visit. Parking attendants are not present at all times. State employees should have their State of Texas ID available if requested by a parking attendant. DPS issued parking stickers on vehicles are not sufficient for free entry after-hours (including weekends).

State Garage B and/or G may be temporarily leased during Moody Center events, for free parking proceed to other open parking locations.

State Garage N is available for free State employee parking and paid public parking for daytime and after-hours parking.
